
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING BLOCK TRANSFER





between College of the Rockies Cranbrook, BC

and

Lethbridge College Lethbridge, AB

This memorandum of understanding constitutes an agreement between Lethbridge College and College of the Rockies.

Objective of the Agreement:

College of the Rockies agrees to facilitate the block transfer of students from Lethbridge College, Accounting, Management, and Business Operations Diploma programs, with appropriate prerequisite qualifications into the 120 credit College of the Rockies Bachelor of Business Administration in Sustainable Business Practices degree. By this agreement, applicants from Lethbridge College who meet the requirements outlined below will be eligible for admission to College of the Rockies with full block transfer, provided all other entrance criteria are met and space remains available in the Bachelor of Business Administration in Sustainable Business Practices degree.

Terms of Agreement

As a partner to this agreement, Lethbridge College agrees:

- To provide opportunity for representatives of College of the Rockies to visit appropriate forums at Lethbridge College to disseminate information about the College of the Rockies Business programs.
- To notify College of the Rockies when changes are made to the Accounting, Management, and Business Operations Diploma programs curriculum; and
- To provide College of the Rockies with updated information annually about the Lethbridge College programs.

As a partner to the agreement, College of the Rockies agrees:

- To provide students holding the Accounting, Management, and Business Operations Diploma programs from Lethbridge with academic acceptance into the Bachelor of Business Administration in Sustainable Business Practices degree at College of the Rockies.
- Whenever possible, to count any undefined transfer credits towards the Bachelor of Business Administration in Sustainable Business Practices degree requirements to avoid students from having to unnecessarily take additional courses to qualify for graduation; and
- To provide Lethbridge College with updated information about the College of the Rockies programs on an annual basis.

Provisions

- This transfer agreement features guaranteed admission into the 3rd year of the Bachelor of Business in Sustainable Business Practices degree for students who have successfully completed all of the courses in the agreement with a Lethbridge College GPA of 2.3 (C+) with a minimum grade of C on transferred courses.
- Courses completed at Lethbridge College under the Business diploma programs prior to this
 agreement and between March 2020 to April 2023 will also be considered for transfer credit
 towards admission into the Bachelor of Business Administration in Sustainable Business
 Practices at College of the Rockies.

Exchange of Information:

Both parties will update the other with respect to changes in their courses and programs that are anticipated or approved.

Both parties agree to make information about this arrangement available to their respective relevant institutional departments and students.

Implementation of this agreement will be through the Registrar's Office at each institution, in consultation with the appropriate authorities in the respective programs.

Duration and Termination of the Agreement

This agreement shall be in place for three years commencing April 1, 2023. The agreement will then be subject to review and renewal. If there are impediments to renewal, College of the Rockies will notify the transfer partner of the impediments, with the goal of negotiating a new agreement. Final approval of the agreement will remain with the President of College of the Rockies.

This MOU may be terminated by either Party at any time provided that the terminating Party gives written notice of its intention at least six months prior to termination.

College of the Rockies retains the right to limit the number of students admitted under this agreement.
