**Part-time studies options and pricing are NOT available to international students due to Canada Study Permit requirements for full-time student status. The above tuition fees include Student Technology Fees, Student Activity Fees and Alumni Fees. The above tuition fees do not include other mandatory fees that may apply including Student Association fees, UPASS fees and lab fees. All international students are also required to pay the following mandatory fees:**

- > \$100 international student application fee
- > \$35 homestay application fee (if homestay accommodation is requested)
- > \$100 one-time international student fee (starting January 2014)

Health insurance coverage is mandatory for all international students. Students with a valid study permit are required to enroll in BC Health Insurance.

**Note 1: The above fee schedule is subject to change as approved by the College's President's Council. Please see “International Student information” on the College's website or contact the International Education Office for further information on fees and refunds for International Students.**

**\* Note 2: As of January 2017, any student wishing to take more than five (5) courses per semester \* must get approval from the international office AND pay an additional one course tuition fee.** \*The only exception is the case when the regular program semester includes more than five courses. In this case the student will not be required to pay the additional one course tuition fee. Students are not permitted to take more than six (6) courses per semester without an education plan and approval of the Registrar.
